Type of Readmission	Inclusion Criteria	
Cardiovascular-cause	Acute coronary syndrome, congestive heart failure, arrhythmia, hypertensive crisis, cerebrovascular accident, peripheral vascular disease	
Pulmonary-cause	Asthma, COPD, pulmonary hypertension, obesity hypoventilation syndrome, hypoxia, interstitial lung disease, pulmonary embolism	
Other-cause	Gastrointestinal	Gastroesophageal reflux disease, cholelithiasis, ileus, GI bleed, diverticulitis, pancreatitis, inflammatory bowel, esophageal spasm, diarrhea, SBO, appendicitis, hepatitis, choledocholithiasis, ileus/constipation
	Infectious	Pneumonia, cellulitis, osteomyelitis, urinary tract infection, human immunodeficiency virus, severe sepsis, septic shock, liver abscess, encephalitis, cholangitis
	Musculoskeletal	Costochondritis, hip fracture, degenerative joint disease, gout, hernia, rotator cuff tear, bone fracture, tension headache
	Neurologic	Spinal stenosis, ataxia, seizure, migraine, headache
	Oncologic	Cancer pain, cancer work up
	Psychiatric	Depression, schizophrenia, PTSD, alcohol intoxication, anxiety, bipolar, psychosis
	Renal	Acute renal failure, acute renal injury
	Urologic	Acute urinary retention, nephrolithiasis, hematuria
	Planned	Planned procedure, surgery
